

PLEASE BE AWARE:

Provision of care during the October Vacation Care period is for 2 week from Monday 30/09/24 to Friday 11/10/24, excluding weekends. Vacation Care is on a casual or flexible basis.

"Fully Booked" Bookings close September 20th 2024 to allow for final numbers to be determined for excursion venues, booking buses and finalising staff.

Vacation Care Terms and Conditions

By booking your child/children into programed Vacation Care days via "Fully Booked" you are giving permission for your child/children to participate in all activities on incursion and excursion days including being transported to and from locations using chartered buses, which are all fitted with regulation seatbelts. Written permission is still required for bus transportation, this will be sent online after bookings close through the schools Edsmart Portal. If you do not wish to use the Edsmart form, please contact us so that we can provide you with a hard copy to complete with parent signature and return to the school admin office or OSHC office, or electronically to oshc.clgps629@schools.sa.edu.au or via Seesaw.

You have seen and are aware of activities on the Vacation Care Program and the details published on the program for each day. Risk assessments are prepared for each incursion and excursion and are available at CLG Primary School OSHC in hard copy form and digitally on the OSHC Seesaw page. Written policies and procedures for transporting children are available at CLGPS OSHC.

Vacation Care bookings will close and online permission forms sent out on Friday 20th September, to ensure staffing and bus transportation numbers can be finalised.

Less than 48 hours' notice of a cancellation will attract the full fee.

*Less than 2 weeks' notice of a cancellation for each excursion day will attract a \$20 fee.

You are aware that children must be at Vacation care by **8.30am** on excursion days as the bus leaves at 9am. All excursions are programed from 9am and 3pm each day, with the exception of the Regal Theatre. Colonel Light Gardens Primary School OSHC is licensed for up to 127 children daily. Staff to child ratios are regulated at 1:8 when on excursions, 1:5 on excursions involving water and on the school site ratios are 1:15.

We ensure that headcounts occur regularly to monitor number of children on excursions and daily attendance sheets and emergency contact details in hard copy form are taken when off school site. All medications and medical plans for individual children including epi-pens and asthma puffers as well as first aid kits, mobile phone and an iPad are also included off site.

Spare sun smart hats will be provided however there is a limited number, please supply one for your child(ren). In the event of extreme weather conditions incursions/excursions that fall on these days may change or be cancelled. Other activities will be provided in such an occurrence.

Children must wear enclosed shoes unless otherwise stated on the program. Always wear sun smart clothing, no singlet tops, crop tops or sports jerseys. Any child who is not dressed appropriately will miss out on certain activities.

On all excursion days a packed recess, lunch and drink bottle filled with water is required. No spending money unless stated on program.

CLG OSHC is a nut aware and sesame aware environment. Please do not supply lunches or snacks consisting of Peanut Butter, Nutella or other Nut products.
